ICT tools in education

This visit was initiated as “Teacher Retraining” activity and organized at the premises of University of Macedonia, Thessaloniki. The schedule of the Workshop consisted of presentations which showed us the experience in usage of ICT in education at all, specially about e-Learning tools.

The first presenter was Vaggelis Grigoropoulos. His presentation was about overview of e-Learning services over the Greek School Network. This network covers 13265 schools, 2543 administrative officers and 58844 teachers. Main services include Internet connection, web-filtering, web page generator, web hosting, school portal.

The second presenter was Mrs. Anna Krassa. She presented the moodle platform used as e-Learning platform. She made overview of existing tools in the e-Learning platform and commented which course management features were mostly used, which tools were specially developed and finally what is the learner experience etc.

Mrs. Fotini Trimmi was the next speaker and presented a demo of usage the system. A lot of details were explained and hints were given about administering the network and software tools.

The final presenter was Evaggelis Pistiougas. His presentation was about CoMPUs – Course Management Platform for Universities. This platform is implemented in the University and there are 17 open courses, 535 registered courses and 5290 users. This means that 38% of all courses are covered in last 2 years of system usage. A lot of details about this course were explained to us along with their experience how they solved problem in initiating and using the system. This presentation motivated us for implementation of similar course management system at University.
