Workshop for Dissemination of Teaching Procedures and Tools

The workshop for Needs Analysis was held at premises of Economic Faculty in Prilep at University St. Clement Ohridski. Official welcome was given by the Dean of the Faculty Prof. D-r and Prof. D-r .

The workshop consisted of several presentations in the scope of the project. The first presenter was Prof. D-r Dilip Patel from London South Bank University. He presented the organization of high education in UK with special accent on quality assurance of teaching procedures and tools.

Prof. D-r Pece Mitrevski presented proposal for New BIT studies as an idea to realize joint study program at least three universities in Macedonia, UKLO, UKIM and SEE. This idea was actually born while working on this project and motivated by implementation of LSBU program for BIT studies to motivate students to study IT, due to decreasing number of students. The main approach is to enable IT specialists to learn more about business since this is the area where they will implement IT solutions. Prof. Mitrevski explained the benefits of realization of this idea.

Prof. D-r Marjan Gusev has demonstrated the usage of Interactive Response Learning System as a tool provided within the project and the Lab for New Innovative Technologies. The wireless devices can be used for teaching purposes enabling the teacher to listen to the audience, to track students' achievement, to motivate direct responsiveness of students, and to analyze which parts were understood and which parts should be explained in more details. Prof. Gusev presented how this system is used in classroom, what are the possibilities and benefits of the project.

As a part of inter-project coaching Mr. Sebastian Kinder from University of Bremen presented details about Diploma Supplement and ECTS implementations at University of Bremen. He pointed out what changes were realized after acceptance of Bologna declaration and introduction of credit system in the project based studies. M. Sc. Antigoni Papadimitriou presented "Comparison of quality assurance in evaluation and accreditation in higher education in Europe". Prof. D-r Vladimir Dukovski presented experience of evaluation process at University Sts. Cyril and Methodius in Skopje. Prof. D-r Tito Belicanec gave presentation about new initiatives in the proposal for new law on High Education. He also described his experience as president of the Board of Accreditation.
